Subject: Flood Planning Grant Award

## **BACKGROUND**

The application for a Community Emergency Preparedness Fund [CEPF] Flood Risk Assessment, Flood Mapping and Flood Mitigation Planning Grant from the Union of BC Municipalities to mitigate flood risk in the Salmon River floodplain was approved by Council in December 2019.

The CEPF is a suite of funding programs intended to enhance the resiliency of local governments and their residents in responding to emergencies. The intent of this funding is to support local governments to ensure that they have accurate knowledge of the flood hazards they face and to develop effective strategies to mitigate and prepare for those risks. The grant program can contribute up to 100% of the cost of eligible activities to a maximum of \$150,000.

## **DISCUSSION**

We have received notice that the grant has been approved. The grant, upon signing, will be awarded in two payments to the Village of Sayward: 50% (\$75,000) when the signed Approval Agreement has been returned to UBCM and 50% (\$75,000) when the project is complete and the final reporting requirements have been met.
