## Event Type: Snow accumulations, Ice and Wind

A weather event is anticipated to impact the Northern-Vancouver Island Service over the next 24-48 hours. Fluctuating temperatures, above and below zero degrees Celsius, are expected to create snow accumulations of up to 10cm in higher terrain and wet icy conditions in lower terrain. This weather will be accompanied by strong wind gusts of up to 90km/h creating poor visibility in areas.

In anticipation Mainroad Crews will be patrolling on all service area highways and applying winter materials where appropriate until the event passes, roadways are clear and back to normal.
