## Event Type: Icing Conditions

As we move into a dry cold period this week throughout Northern Vancouver Island road users may encounter black ice or other icing conditions. Particularly in the early hours of the day dew, humidity, runoff from snow and the fluctuating air and road temperatures will cause ice on the roads. Mainroad crews are actively pre-treating roads to try and prevent the ice from forming and patrolling to address areas as conditions arise.
