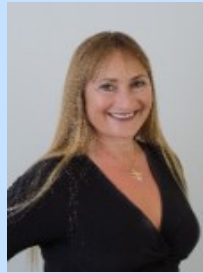

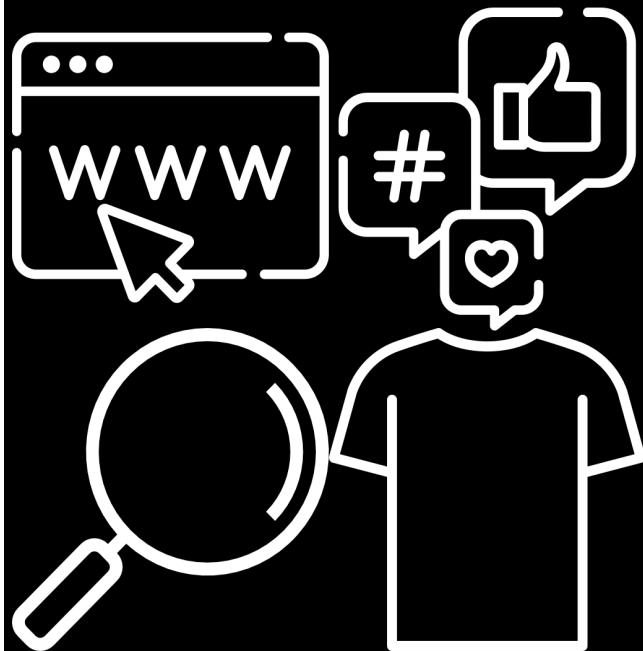

## Garden Club News

Leaves are falling, providing good mulching material for the garden. A good layer of mulch will protect the roots of over-wintered plants from the effects of killing frosts by retaining the warmth that remains in the soil. Raspberries can benefit from removing the dead canes and thinning out the weaker canes and shortening and tying up the stronger ones.

December is a good month to order seeds and plan the garden for next year. By drawing a garden diagram we can ensure that we don't plant the same crop in an area that has been used for that variety in previous years. By rotating our growing we can avoid problems like club root that can remain in the soil. Liming with dolomite lime now can give time to reduce acid level in the soil and add the needed nutrients calcium and magnesium.

A lot of fun was had at the November meeting of the club when we spent the evening making festive Christmas decorations from natural materials. The Heritage Hall was filled with the fragrant aromas of evergreen boughs and other vegetation. With the addition of cones, candles, ribbon and a little creativity we produced some beautiful wreathes, swags, centerpieces and gnomes.

The December 11th meeting will be our Christmas pot luck dinner. We will also feature an exchange of our home made preserves. **Does being outside in the cold actually make you sick?**

Here is what the science tells us:

- a 2017 study in the Archives of Virology journal found that there are certain anti-viral cells in our respiratory tract that are impaired by cold weather
- The BC CDC consensus is that the actual impact of cold weather is that it causes people to spend more time indoors around sick people in poorly ventilated spaces

So, while the cold weather does have some impact on our body's ability to fight viruses, it is actually a combination of several factors, primarily poor hand hygiene and proximity to sick people that causes the cold.

**Other myths about the common cold**

- **Going out in the rain causes the cold** (rain has no effect on viral transmission)
- **Going out with wet hair causes the cold** (this only causes discomfort, not illness)
- **Vitamin C helps stave off colds** (vitamin C helps with recovery from illness, not prevention)
- **Having cold feet causes the cold** (a 2005 study found that only 10% of people with chilled feet reported cold symptoms afterward)

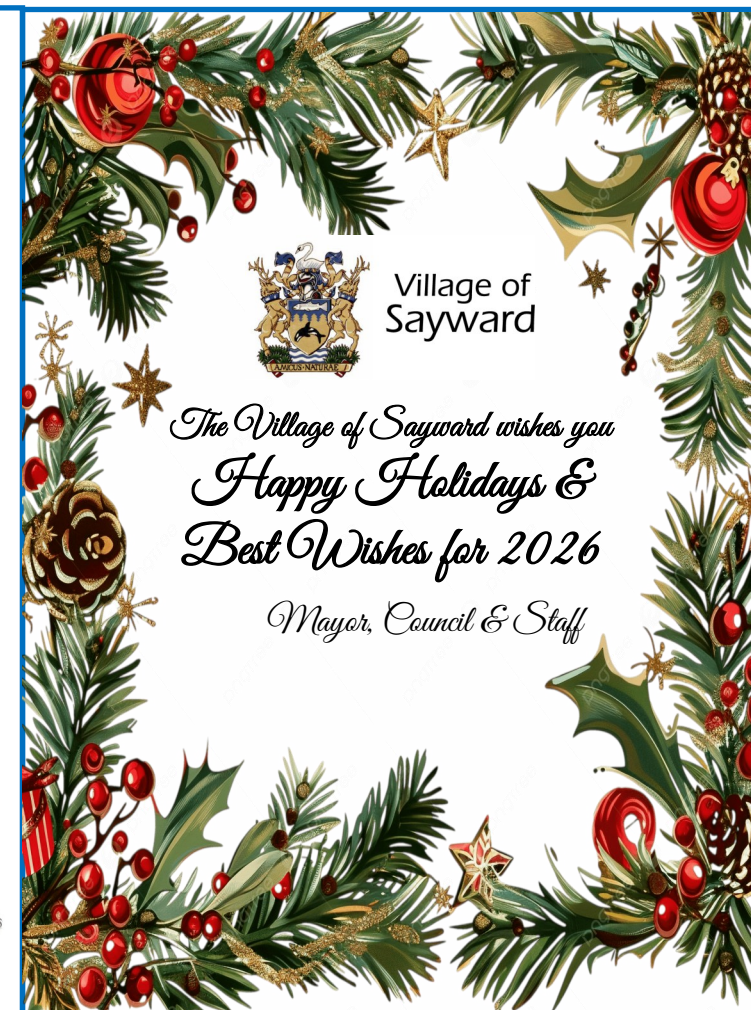
