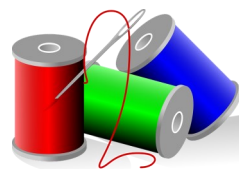

Emergency Phone Notification System

The Village of Sayward in conjunction with the Strathcona Regional District uses **Alertable** as our public emergency mass notification service.

Alertable can notify residents, visitors, and businesses of emergencies in a timely manner to people who subscribe to receive these alerts. It can also be used to notify residents of other non-emergency items such as scheduled road closures, power outages, water and sewer alerts, and much more. This service is free.

The system is compatible with mobile phones, tablets, computers or smart speakers. It can also send alerts via text message, voice calls to land lines, and e-mail.

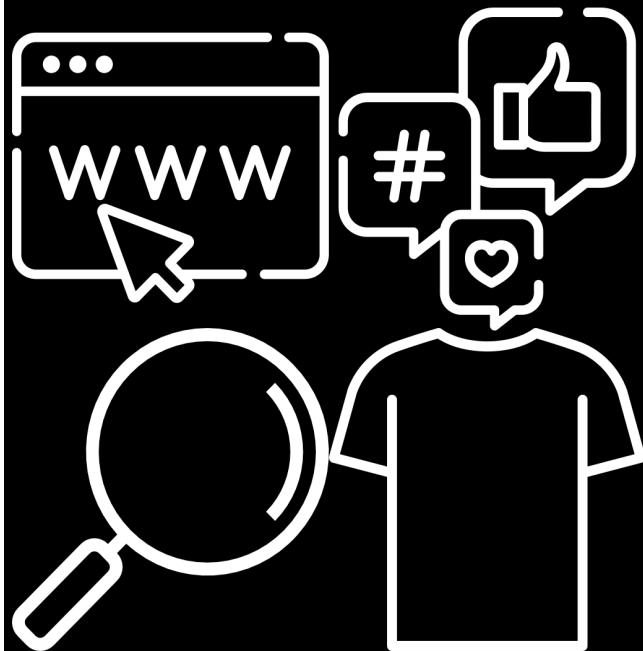

Garden Club News

With the turn of the year we experience days that are shorter and often rainy. Fortunately the rain keeps the frost away and we still get some warmer days to get out in the garden. This is the time when gardeners are planting garlic. With some bone meal and some well rotted compost we ensure some good sized garlic to harvest next summer. This is also a good time to plant bulbs for tulips and daffodils (narcissus). These also like some bone meal in the hole when planting.



The October meeting of the club featured presentations on composting. First there was a discussion on the general principles of composting (carbon/nitrogen ratios, turning and protection from rain). Following that, Debbie gave an engaging demonstration of the details of worm composting. That system will allow you to dispose of food wastes in an odor-free system within your home to produce a supply of worm castings to fertilize your garden.

At the November 13th meeting of the Garden Club we will be making Christmas decorations. Using natural materials gathered from our gardens and forest we will be building wreathes, centre pieces, swags and gnomes. This has been a fun event in past years with lots of creative spirit. Everyone from the community is welcome to come and participate as we will have a good supply of materials available. Please come and join us at 7:00 at the Heritage Hall.

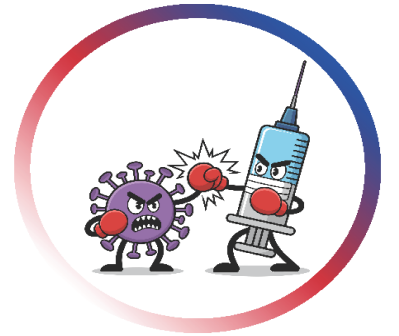
Flu Season Is Upon Us!

To help keep the entire sewer system working well, it's important *not* to flush or put the following products down drains:

- ⇒ Hygiene products (e.g. sanitary napkins/liners, tampons, condoms, cotton swabs, dental floss, diapers, wipes, paper towels, tissues)
- ⇒ Fats, oils, butter, lard and cooking grease
- ⇒ Medication (e.g. pills, syrups, vitamins)
- ⇒ Household hazardous waste (e.g. paints, thinners, solvents, bleach, ammonia, pesticides)
- ⇒ Car and garage products (e.g. motor oil, transmission fluid, degreasers, battery acid, antifreeze)

WINTER IS COMING

Your Public Works department strives to keep our roads clear of ice and snow every winter. To assist us in making our roads safe for you, Council is asking residents to remove from Village boulevards all trailers, boats, recreational vehicles, rocks, wood piles, or any other items that may get in the way of snow removal. For the purpose of snow removal, the boulevard is considered the paved portion of the roadway plus a 12-foot shoulder on either side of the paved portion. These items are asked to be moved and kept off boulevards between the following dates:

November 15th to March 15th



DO NOT park any vehicles on boulevards during snow events. This will allow the Public Works department to clear roads efficiently and safely.



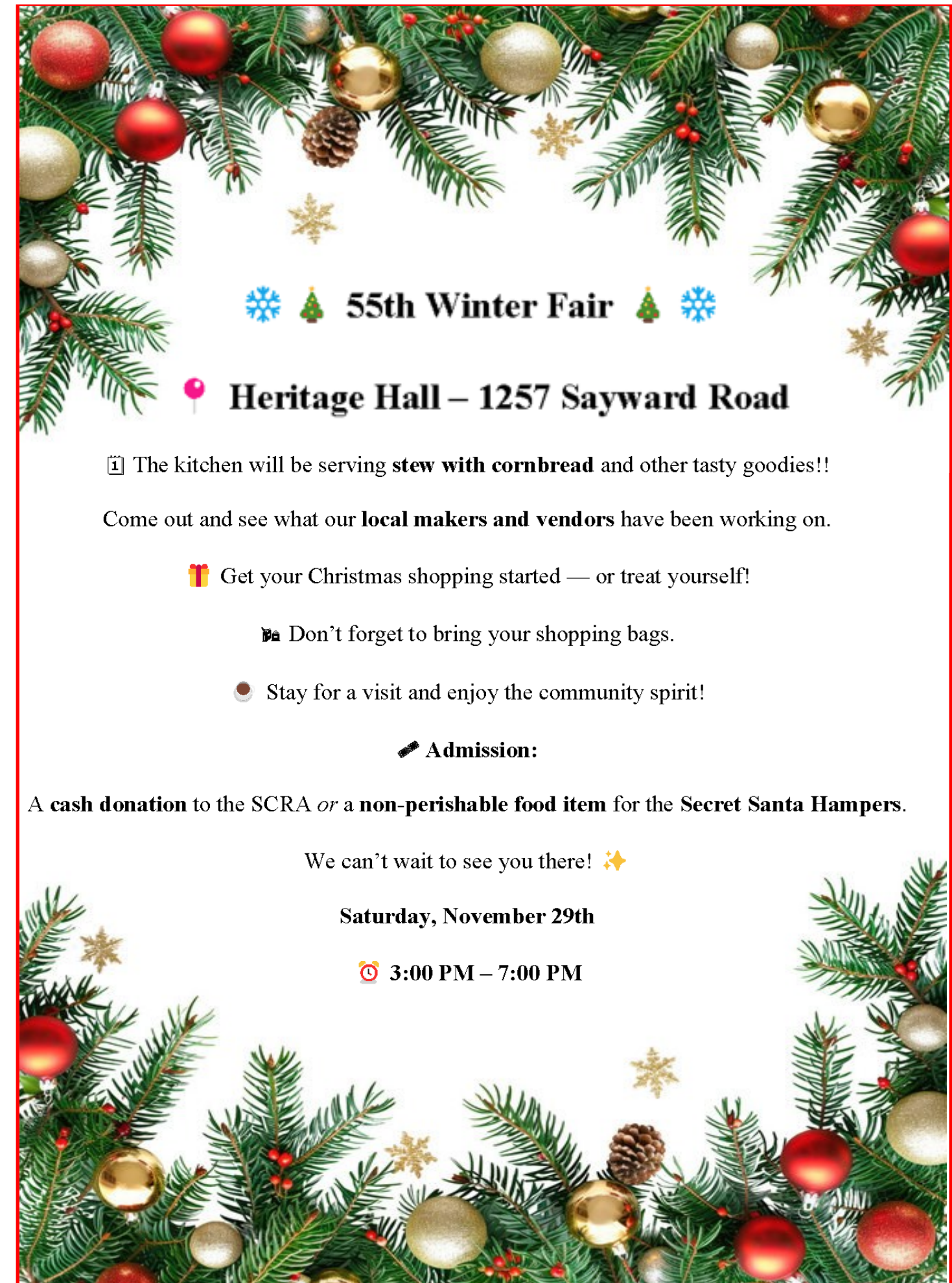
On garbage day, ensure all garbage cans are off the roadway. Please keep all bins in your driveway, walkway, or on the boulevard shoulder as far back from the road as possible.



When clearing snow from your driveway, please place snow on your property or boulevard shoulder area. Placing snow on the paved roadway obstructs traffic and makes travel unsafe.

Council and Village crews appreciate the effort put in by all residents to keep the boulevards clear and safe. Thank you for preparing for the winter season now.
