Community Presentation: Living Safely with Wildlife – All Welcome!

Sayward Village and Valley residents are invited to attend an upcoming community presentation hosted by the Wild Wise Society. The presentation will explore how we can safely and respectfully coexist with **Black Bears, Grizzly Bears, and Cougars**. The session will review important behaviours of Black Bears, Grizzly Bears, and Cougars, and identify actions that we can take to avoid human-wildlife conflicts; for example, by reducing attractants around homes and communities.

Speaker: Mollie Cameron

Mollie has been President of Wild Wise Society since 2023, following many years of dedicated volunteer service. She works with the Commercial Bear Viewing Association of B.C.



and is a trained bear viewing guide with a strong passion for wildlife-first, sustainable experiences. Mollie has also spent six years independently studying cougars on South Vancouver Island. A seasoned marine mammal naturalist and whale watching skipper now in her tenth season, she contributes to marine mammal research and rescue efforts.
