**A Council meeting is scheduled for
Tuesday August 18, 2026 at 7:00 PM in the
Village of Sayward Council Chambers located at
652 H'Kusam Way, Sayward, BC**

The first part of the Special Meeting of Council is open to the public to attend in person in Council Chambers. Paper copies of the meeting agenda can be picked up at the Municipal Office during regular business hours.

The first purpose of the open meeting is to enable Council to receive some correspondence, and deal with some reports.

The second purpose of the meeting is to enable Council to convene a Special In Camera meeting of Council in accordance with Section 92 of the Community Charter, which would then be closed to the public so that Council may give consideration to matters in accordance with the following sections of the Community Charter:

- a) 90 (1)(c) labour relations or other employee relations;
- b) 90 (1)(d) the security of the property of the municipality;
- c) 90 (1)(e) the acquisition, disposition or expropriation of land or improvements, if the council considers that disclosure

- d) 90 (1)(g) litigation or potential litigation affecting the municipality;
 - e) 90(1)(h) the receipt of advice that is subject to solicitor-client privilege, including communications necessary for that purpose.
 - f) 90 (1)(j) information that is prohibited, or information that if it were presented in a document would be prohibited, from disclosure under section 21 of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*;
 - g) 90(1)(k) negotiations and related discussions respecting the proposed provision of a municipal service that are at their preliminary stages and that, in the view of the council, could reasonably be expected to harm the interests of the municipality if they were held in public;
 - h) 90 (1)(m) a matter that, under another enactment, is such that the public may be excluded from the meeting;
 - i) 90 (1)(n) the consideration of whether a council meeting should be closed under a provision of this subsection or subsection (2).
