BYLAW NO. 211, 1990

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF SAYWARD TO ESTABLISH REGULATIONS AND CONTROL OF PARKS AND PARKS PROPERTY

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Sayward deems it wise and expedient to establish regulations for the control of parks;

AND WHEREAS certain parcels of land within the Municipality are reserved for park purposes for the use and enjoyment of the general public;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Sayward in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Parks Control Bylaw No. 211, 1990".
2. No person shall destroy, cut, mark, break, dig, pull up, burn or in any other way damage, injure, remove or deface:
 - (a) any tree, flower bed, bush, shrub, plant, sod, grass or other vegetation, soil, sand, gravel or wood;
 - (b) any monument, fountain, bridge, fence, wall, gate, roadway, pavement, parking area, sidewalk, walk or other erection or improvement
 - (c) any building or other structure
 - (d) any swing, slide, playground apparatus, table, seat, bench, sign, bleacher or other fixture, equipment or personal property or ornament or utility placed, erected or maintained in a park.
3. No person shall in a park, without the without the written permission of Council:
 - (a) operate an amplifying system or loud speaker;
 - (b) make public address or demonstration or do any other activity likely to cause a public gathering or attract public attention;
 - (c) take part in any procession, march, drill, performance, ceremony, concert, gathering or meeting.
4. No person shall permit any dogs or other animals to enter any stream, pool or lake within the limits of a park. No person shall permit a dog to enter a park where posted "No Dogs Permitted".

5. (a) No person shall place, dump or leave any foreign material of any nature whatsoever, including, but not limited to, sand, gravel or earth fill in or upon or about any park unless he/she has received written permission of Council;
- (b) No person shall deposit bottles, broken glass, paper, cardboard or empty cartons or other rubbish, trash or garbage other than into a refuse receptacle provided for such purpose;
- (c) No person shall deposit any household waste or trade waste in any refuse receptacle in a park.
6. No person shall drive, park or stand any vehicle on a park other than on roads, lanes or parking lots which have been designated for such use.
7. No person shall ride, lead or herd horses or other animals of any kind through or in any park, other than on trails, roads or lanes which have been designated for such use.
8. No person shall hit, propel, throw or direct a projectile that is considered dangerous use of a public park facility. The shooting of arrows, etc. are not permitted on public parks. Only activities normally associated with use of the parks are permitted. This would include such activities as baseball, football, rugby, tennis, fastball, soccer etc.
9. No person or persons shall overnight camp on any park.
10. Notwithstanding Section 9, the Council may, on application permit overnight parking in any park.
11. The Council may permit or allow exclusive or special use of a park or portion of a park by any person or persons, and may issue to such a person or persons a permit and may provide in the permit such conditions as Council deems appropriate.
12. No person shall, without the approval of Council, offer for sale any article of food, drink or merchandise or carry on any business within the limits of a park.
13. Notwithstanding anything in these regulations, the Council may, at any time, temporarily close to public use a park or portion thereof.
14. Any person who violates any provision of this Bylaw or who allows, causes or permits any infraction of this Bylaw shall be guilty of an infraction of this Bylaw and shall be liable upon conviction to the maximum penalty provided for in the Offence Act, RSBC 1979.
15. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Bylaw is for any reason held to be invalid by the decision of any Court of competent jurisdiction, the decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Bylaw.
