BYLAW NO. 220, 1991

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH WATER CONNECTION CHARGES TO THE VILLAGE OF SAYWARD.

The Council of the Village of Sayward, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the Village of Sayward Water Connection Charges Bylaw No. 220, 1991.
2. For the purpose of this Bylaw, the following definition shall apply:

“Water Connection” shall refer to a pipe 20 millimeters (3/4”) or more in diameter connected to a main water supply pipe and extending to a shut-off valve one foot from the boundary of the property to be serviced with a water supply. The water connection shall be the property of the Village of Sayward.
3. The following charge shall be made for water connections within the Village of Sayward.

For a 20 millimeter (3/4”) water connection, the charge shall be on a cost plus fee basis with a minimum charge of \$300.00.
4. The water connection charge or a deposit in the amount of 125% of the estimated cost, shall be paid to the Village of Sayward before a water connection is installed.
5. Water rates and regulation Bylaw No. 88, 1978, is hereby repealed.
6. This Bylaw becomes effective upon registration.
7. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Bylaw is for any reason held to be invalid by the decision of any Court of competent jurisdiction, the decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Bylaw.
