BYLAW NO. 431

A BYLAW TO AMEND FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES BYLAW NO. 383, 2010

WHEREAS the Office of the Fire Commissioner has required Fire Department Service levels to be formally established;

AND WHEREAS the Office of the Fire Commissioner has established three distinct Service Levels for Fire Departments;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Municipal Council of the Village of Sayward, in open meeting assembled, hereby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. **TITLE:**

This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Fire Protection Services Amendment Bylaw No. 431, 2016".

2. **AMENDMENT:**

Fire Protection Services Bylaw No. 383, 2010 is hereby amended by deleting section 3 in its entirety and replacing it as follows:

3. a) Subject to the *Fire Services Act* and the Fire Code, this bylaw establishes fire protection regulations for the Village of Sayward.
- b) The service level provided by the Fire Department, in accordance with the requirements of the Office of the Fire Commissioner for British Columbia, defined in the British Columbia Fire Service Minimum Training Standards Structure Firefighters Competency and Training Playbook shall be Exterior Operations. The Incident Commander is hereby provided the authority to change the service level at an incident to either Interior Service or Full Service based upon the training levels of the responders attending the incident whether such responders are members of the Fire Department or members of another fire department responding under mutual aid agreements existing at that time.
